### **ASSESSMENT**

#### **Formative Assessment**

Use to inform instruction
Significant basis of student learning data
Regular, common assessments to track student progress
Quick turnaround to support decision making
In class, CFU, Whiteboards, Fist to Five, etc.
Assess what is essential

#### **Summative Assessment**

Summarizes a block of learning
Also can inform instruction, but not as immediate
Standardized Testing
Understanding by Design (Wiggins and McTighe)

Based upon student learning data/formatives Teacher led, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesdays Find practices to support student learning Look at groups and individuals **Schmoker and Dufour** Determine what is essential/How to calibrate
